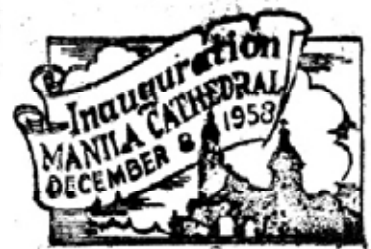
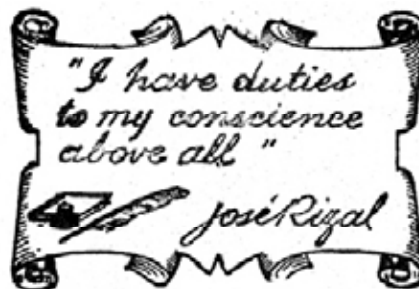
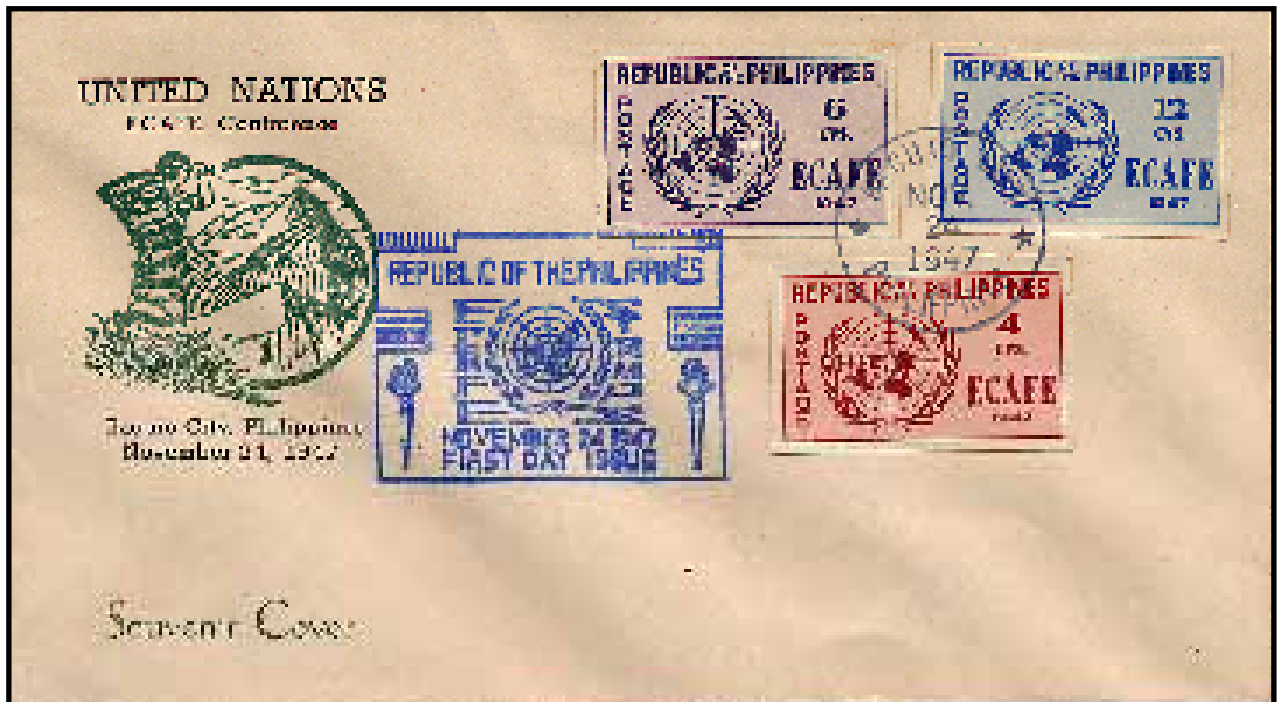

**FIRST DAY ADDITIONAL CACHETS, no cancels**

First Day Cachets are used by the Manila Central Post Office or sometimes by Provincial Post Offices for the first day of issue of new stamps or Postal stationery. Normally they are additional to the First Day Cancel and come in different ink colours.
